CONCERT NOTES

ALEX MORTIMER:

A member of a very well known brass banding family, he was born in Yorkshire. He began his playing career at the age of 10 as a cornettist with Luton Red Cross Band. After playing various instruments he finally settled on euphonium. He was soloist with Fodens Band and the Halle Orchestra from 1924 to 1944. Among bands he has directed are Scottish C.W.S., Black Dyke Mills and C.W.S. (Manchester).

CARLTON MAIN FRICKLEY COLLIERY:

Formerly known as South Elmsall and Frickley Colliery Band. They have won prizes in the National and Open Championships. Also at Edinburgh Festival.

ROBERT OUGHTON:

Was formerly musical director of Scottish C.W.S. Band and is a noted cornet soloist and virtuoso.

WINGATES TEMPERANCE BAND:

Founded in 1873 by the Independent Methodist Bible Class. Also a very well known band concert and contest wise. A championship band for over 50 years.

DENNIS SMITH:

Former musical director of Hoggarths Works. Noted euphoniumist with C.W.S. (Manchester) and Fodens.
