REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE

FOR THE

Year ending October 31st, 1900.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,

In presenting our Tenth Annual Report and Balance Sheet, we regret we are not in so favourable a position as we had hoped to find ourselves at the close of the financial year.

During the year the band has fulfilled the following engagements, viz.:—The Queen's Birthday and Relief of Mafeking Celebration on May 24th ; Spa Gardens, June 7th and 21st ; the Athletic Festival on the Harrogate Cricket Ground, Aug. 6th, 7th, and 25th ; Spa Gardens, Aug. 25th ; Wells House (Ilkley) Garden Party, Sept. 1 ; British Association, Sept. 8th ; Railway Servants' Annual Church Parade, Sept. 30th ; for which the members of the band have received the sum of forty-six pounds thirteen shillings (£46 13s. 0d.), less than two pounds each, a gratuity of one pound from the Municipal Orchestra being included.

We have also given three concerts in aid of the Local War Funds, and one joint concert with the Harrogate Prize Glee Society ; two for the Harrogate Cottage Hospital ; and one each for the Harrogate Temperance Union and the Salvation Army Self-Denial Fund.

Four contests have been attended, and one 2nd and half-share in 3rd prize were won.

Twenty Sunday concerts have been given during the season, which have been very successful, at one of which (Sept. 16th) the Harrogate Prize Glee Society kindly gave two selections of their music, which were highly appreciated by a large gathering of people.

In conclusion, we thank all our numerous friends and patrons for their practical sympathy, which, considering the many calls that have been made for various objects, has been very good.
