Players

We welcome two new players to the Band, and hope that they will soon take up membership. Charles Hindmarsh (Eb Bass) is an ex-member who now lives in Leeds. He has conducted other bands since he left us and is also proficient on the violin - you may remember his impromptu demonstration of musical saw playing one time while the Band was waiting to enter a contest! Eddie Fearnley (BBb bass) has recently moved to Harrogate from Wigan, and although he has not played with a band for some time, he was a member of the Cheshire and National Youth Bands in the past. Coincidentally, he played with the Latchford Band in Warrington for some years - overlapping slightly (we think!) with Gavin who spent six years with them before transferring to Harrogate.

Jason Harper has tendered his resignation from the Band. He gives his reasons as being a gradual loss of interest in the Band and playing, and a lack of commitment and dedication to the instrument. He was asked to remain with the Band until London, but he has made plans for a European trip which will mean he would not be available in August, September and probably October. He will be sorely missed. His playing of the soprano and mastery of that most difficult of instruments were an achievement in themselves, and his absence in the ensemble will be very noticeable.

Of course, this now leaves us looking for a replacement - anyone with any ideas, please let the Committee know ASAP! We hope to see one or two new cornet players coming for a "blow" in the near future, but are still on the look-out for others.
